People Offering Resources Together (PORT) provides emergency shelter, dinner and breakfast for over 20 weeks from November through March. Over 130 interfaith groups provide the facilities, volunteers, food, clothes, and other resources to homeless men, women, and children in the area. A different church is a host for the shelter each week.

PORT is hosted by community churches that start preparing two (2) months prior to November. The program runs from November - March or April, and hosted weekly by different churches.
