Testing services are provided by a licensed clinical psychologist. Testing tools assess academic and projective functioning of individuals. This review session is included in the cost of the service.

A psychological assessment can be beneficial in answering specific questions regarding an individual's learning style, cognitive functioning, contributing factors towards behavioral and relational interactions or diagnosing or ruling out the following conditions:

- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD);
- Learning Disabilities;
- Axis I Diagnosis such as: Bipolar Disorder, Anxiety, Depression, Post-traumatic Stress Disorder, and Eating Disorders.

Specific testing for Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD) or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity

Disorder can be done at a partial testing rate. This testing is a shorter time period of testing and interpretation. This focuses more on assessing attention and ability to control impulsive behavior.
