Other services offered are end of life planning and care; pain and symptom management; disease management and education; assistance with transitions from the hospital to home and from the home to hospital; medication management; social, emotional and spiritual support; siblings support programs; and bereavement support. The patient's physician is not replaced but works in conjunction with the team to provide appropriate care for the child.
