The Virginia Rent Relief Program (RRP) is designed to support housing stability during the COVID-19 pandemic by providing financial assistance and rent payments for eligible households. This includes payments past due beginning April 1, 2020. Financial assistance is a one-time payment with the opportunity for renewal based on the availability of funding and the household's need for additional assistance and continued eligibility.
