The program helps to remove barriers to housing such as unemployment, histories of incarceration, sobriety, and mental health care, and prioritizes providing permanent housing.

The staff provides case management services aimed at housing stability. Services may include assistance with locating and moving into a permanent housing unit,

connecting with benefits, employment assistance, connecting with medical and mental health care, and other needs identified during intake.
